Theme: Creating positive impacts on SDGs through procurement

With the adoption of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, UN has identified 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in 2015 for all sectors, including both public and private sectors, to internalize and prioritize these goals across organizational policy, strategy, operation and objective.

SDG 12. "Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns" and its Target 12.7 therein are referring to the need to promote sustainable procurement practices. It is clearly pointing at procurement as one of the UN strategies towards the achievement of the SDGs.

Procurement can be seen as a "soft" but effective approach to encourage markets to supply more sustainable products, and achieve resource efficiency, tackle climate change and address social issues ranging from human rights and gender equality, to decent work and employment.

This webinar aims at introducing the procurement strategies and practices which could be integrated in procurement and supply chain management for creating positive sustainability impacts and value for your organization. Procurement professionals could be one of the major enablers for contributing to 17 SDGs.
